Run safety

- Read run communication so you know where we are going
- Road safety is the of paramount importance
- Drive a safe distance behind other vehicles, but don't lag behind
- If necessary, overtake a slow vehicle
- Give the leader space to ensure full view in mirrors
- When the run leader pulls to the side of the road, follow with absolute safety; don't
 - o Stay on the road and impede the flow of traffic
 - o Leave the right-hand wheels on the roadway
- If it is unsafe to pull over, keep driving until it is safe to pull over
- Don't try to anticipate the run leader
