Draft Advice to Member's Seeking HVS or CVS Registration

Introduction

MCMA members are advised to follow the steps below so as to ensure a smooth process in the registration or re-registration of their vehicle/s under the Historic Vehicle Scheme (HVS) and/or the Classic Vehicle Scheme (CVS).

Please note that most MCMA vehicles will be registered under HVS. These vehicles are in original condition or may have the accessories/modifications approved by MCMA. A smaller number of vehicles will be registered under CVS. These vehicles have modifications not approved by MCMA but are listed in VSI 6 as not requiring an engineer's certification. Vehicles requiring an engineer's certificate might be registered under CVS by MCMA through Council of Heritage Motor Clubs (CHMC) on a case by case basis.

Steps

1. Ensure that you are a financial member of MCMA.
2. Ensure that your vehicle is at least 30 years old.
3. Ensure that your vehicle is in roadworthy condition.
4. At least one month before registration is due, commence the steps detailed below.
5. Determine whether your vehicle is eligible for HVS or CVS. Refer to the attached list of MCMA Approved Accessories and Modifications, and to VSI 6 (see link below).
6. For **NEW** registrations, the following is required:

Proof of Ownership	AUVIS Report (Blue Slip)
Proof of Identity	Application for Conditional Registration
Import Approval (if imported)	Proof of Ownership
Historic Vehicle Declaration Form	Proof of Identify
AIS Safety Inspection Report (Pink Slip)	Import Approval if (imported)
AUVIS Report (Blue Slip) if been unregistered	Classic Vehicle Declaration (RMS)
MCMA Member's Declaration	Classic Vehicle Agreement (CHMC)
Inspection by an MCMA Scrutineer	MCMA Member's Declaration
	Inspection by an MCMA Registration Officer

7. For **RENEWALS**, the following is required.

Historic Vehicle Scheme (HVS)	Classic Vehicle Scheme (CVS)
AIS Safety Inspection Report (Pink Slip)	AIS Safety Inspection Report (Pink Slip)
Historic Vehicle Declaration Form	Classic Vehicle Agreement (CHMC)
Inspection by an MCMA Scrutineer	Classic Vehicle Declaration (RMS)
MCMA Member's Declaration	Inspection by an MCMA Registration Officer
